Mode of Action

Two-fold:

1. Nourishment of upper skin layers: maximal physiological function
2. Stimulation of fibroblasts; collagen secretion

Underlying theory

Beyond the age of 35 two events take place.

In women, oestrogen levels decrease even 10 years before menopause. Microcirculation to the upper skin layers is dependant upon oestrogen. As oestrogen levels fall, so does the microcirculation. As a result, nutrition to the skin diminishes.

Reduced nutrition means reduced ability to function and to recover from damaging events, such as UV light, pollution and even movement. Decreased function and repair results in diminishing skin quality, typically seen in women over 35.

Fibroblasts are responsible for maintaining the integrity of the skin layers and their holding together. Fibroblasts also manufacture collagen, heal wounds and have contractile ability.

Beyond the age of 35, fibroblast activity diminishes and they become less responsive to trauma. Many minor events such as lines (in fact a wound) go un-healed. Fibroblasts can be stimulated by controlled trauma as in the vitamin facial. Once reawakened, they heal fine lines, reassert skin tone and secrete collagen.

Frequency

Every 2 weeks x 4

Then every 4 weeks x 4

Then every 6 weeks x 4

Then every 8 weeks

This treatment can be performed every week.

Vitamin facial can be associated with a glycolic acid mask or peel for best results. Perform the peel first and then proceed immediately to the vitamin facial.

Pain factor

Most people tolerate vitamin facial without anaesthetic.

Some people like anaesthetic around the mouth.

Some people like anaesthetic all over.

Glycolic acid mask, microdermabrasion or peeling increases the absorption of both the anaesthetic and the vitamin mix.
